## Public Safety Committee Meeting

The Public Safety Committee met on Thursday, January 30, 2020 at 5:30 p.m. at 316 S. Brad Street, Grantsburg, WI.

Committee Chairman Peer called the Recreation Committee Meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

**Discussion/Action:** Mike Alderman – Security camera for downtown. Mike Alderman, owner of Jensen-Sundquist Insurance Agency, located on Main Street, addressed the committee about partnering with the Village to get security camera(s) in the downtown area. He felt this would be a pro-active way to discourage vandalism in the downtown area and theft from the downtown businesses. He has been in contact with Beau Carey, Carey Communications, about the Ring Security System. This system, with two (2) solar powered cameras that record activities, could be installed by Carey Communications for approximately \$800.00. The system would require Wi-Fi and may also require a small monthly fee to retain the recordings for a longer period (maybe 30 days). Carey will be invited to a future Public Safety Committee meeting to discuss more details. The committee thanked Alderman for his research and for bringing this to their attention.

**Discussion/Action: Bond Schedule amount changes.** Police Chief Wald requested the amount currently charged for a paper service fee be increased from \$25 to \$40 which will match what Burnett County Sheriff's Department is currently charging. **Motion by Trustee Peer, second by President Longhenry to recommend the Village Board increase the charge for a paper service from \$25 to \$40. Motion carried.** 

Police Chief Wald reported on the following items: part-time officers, chief training, squad & equipment garage, fundraiser for Emergency Response Team, Frigid 5 race and call for service info sheet.

<u>Discussion/Action: Adjournment</u>. Motion by President Longhenry, second by Trustee Peer to adjourn the meeting at 6:05. Motion carried.
