

The Recreation Committee for the Village of Grantsburg met on Tuesday, July 27, 2021 at 6:00 p.m. at the Village Office, 316 S. Brad Street, Grantsburg, Wisconsin.

Present: Chairman/Trustee Caylin Muehlberg, Trustee Diane Barton, Trustee Kayla Woody

<u>Call to Order</u> Chairman Muehlberg called the Recreation Committee meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

<u>Community Center</u> 1) Two-day events. Discussion was held on how to charge for two-day events that are held in the Community Center. Motion by Trustee Barton, second by Trustee Woody to recommend the Village Board approve charging an additional \$150 per day for multi-day events, held on consecutive days, starting on the second day of the event. Motion passed unanimously. 2) Gymnastic equipment. C/T Meyer let the committee know Kathy Lund, gymnastics coach, asked to leave the equipment up until the high school season begins this fall with the understanding she would take everything down when/if needed for a rental.

<u>Campground 1) 2022 rates</u>. The committee reviewed a history of rates charged for camping. Motion by Trustee Woody, second by Trustee Barton to recommend the Village Board keep the 2022 campground rates the same as 2021 rates. Motion passed unanimously. <u>2) Seasonal agreement</u>. The committee reviewed a draft Seasonal Camper Agreement prepared by Deputy C/T Longhenry. Motion by Chairman Muehlberg, second by Trustee Woody to recommend the Village Board approve the 2022 Seasonal Camping Agreement as presented with the date changes and mowing day change. Motion passed unanimously.

Pool Operations Discussion was held on a daily swim discount card that was sold after the start of the season. Two families have purchased the card which offers ten (10) daily swims for the cost of eight (8). The committee decided to request the pool manager prepare a list of proposed programs, events and discounts for the 2022 swimming season, prior to the start of the season, for the committee and Village Board to approve.

<u>Splashpad</u> The committee discussed possible grants available to assist with the splashpad currently being fundraised for by the Grantsburg Revitalization Organization (GRO). C/T Meyer was asked to contact GRO to see what grants have already been applied for.

<u>Skating Rink</u> The committee discussed possible off-season uses for the area at Memory Lake Park that is used for a public skating rink in the winter. Trustee Peer had previously reported Rotary was investigating possible uses. He will be contacted to see if they are still discussing.

Adjournment. Chairman Muehlberg adjourned the meeting at 6:55 p.m.
