

The Village of Grantsburg Recreation Committee met on Monday, January 10, 2022, at 5:30 p.m. at the Village Office, 316 Brad Street S, Grantsburg, WI 54840.

Chairman Muchlberg called the Recreation Committee meeting to order at 5:32 p.m. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

**Discussion/Action: 2022 Community Center rental agreement with Grantsburg School District for gymnastics and storage of equipment.** The committee discussed the current contract with the Grantsburg School District regarding weekend use. One concern was that the school would rent the community center on weekends at their \$7.00 hourly rate to avoid a full tear down of the gymnastics equipment. Motion by Chairman Muehlberg, second by Trustee Woody to present to the full board to continue with the current rental agreement and adding 'weekends will be rented at the regular weekend rate'. Motion carried.

**Discussion/Action: Community Center Rental Agreement.** The committee discussed current rates for the community center and when we would require full gym tear downs. Clerk/Treasurer Meyer commented our insurance company has not provided a definite answer on whether we should always require a full tear down. The committee discussed a full tear down should not be necessary for small or medium groups using less than half of the gym. Also, the committee discussed the gap between small group of less than 30 and needing a full gym for more than 30 people. Motion by Chairman Muehlberg, second by Trustee Woody to present to the full board to add to the community center agreement for half gym rentals at \$25 per hour with a 2-hour minimum not to exceed \$150 for a whole day. Motion carried.

**Discussion/Action: Community Center kitchen supplies.** The committee discussed the need for better kitchen supplies in the community center to make the space more appealing to rent and possibly adding doors to the existing cabinets. Clerk/Treasurer Meyer and Deputy Clerk/Treasurer were asked to get a list of what is needed and pricing for cabinet doors. Not motion made.
