

Riverside Cemetery

Grantsburg, WI

Current Fees-

\$500 one plot (Village Resident), \$800 one plot (Non-Resident)

\$100 second burial (Village Resident), \$200 second burial (Non-Resident)

Resale: \$400 one plot (Village Resident), \$600 one plot (Non-Resident) or 80% of purchase price & perpetual care is forfeited

\$80 second burial (Village Resident), \$160 second burial (Non-Resident) or 80% of purchase price

Rules -

1. Retaining Walls and Grave Boarders: No cement retaining walls shall be permitted. All grave borders shall be flush with the grade of said lot.
2. Monuments and Markers: Foundations for monuments shall not be less than five (5) feet in depth, constructed full length and width of die from top to bottom of a good grade of concrete and stone (reinforced concrete.) All markers erected in said Cemetery shall be set flush with the grade of the lot, in order to permit free lawn mowing of said lot. The Village Board is to have complete supervision of all memorial erections.
3. Shrubbery and Plants: All planting of shrubbery and plants shall be first approved by the Village of Grantsburg including type and placement. Watering of all shrubbery and plants is the responsibility of the person planting or ordering the planting(s).
4. Flowers and other Memorial items: All flowers, plastic or fresh, must be placed securely in elevated urns or baskets on a shepard's hook - immediately adjacent and in line with the headstone. All flowers, plastic or fresh, must be removed by October 15th of each year. Any memorial items must be placed so to be out of the way of mowing. Watering of all flowers is the responsibility of the person placing the flowers at the gravesite or ordering the flowers be placed at the gravesite.
5. Grading of Lots: All grading of lots in said cemetery shall conform to the natural grade where said lot is located.
6. Traffic: (a) All vehicles shall drive on the graveled streets only. (b) All trucks or vehicles leaving the graveled streets or returning to graveled streets, for memorial erections or other purposes, shall use plank to drive said vehicles upon, and under no circumstances will this rule be deviated, (memorial erections, removal of memorials, foundation materials and work, dirt hauling, or any trucking.) (c) Pedestrians shall walk on designated streets and alleys in going to and from their lots, or in visiting lots in said cemetery.
7. Opening and Closing Graves: The Village of Grantsburg or a designee shall open and close graves at seasonal rates as set by the Village Board, and no graves to be opened, unless supervised by the Village of Grantsburg or a designee.
8. Cremations: There will be no more than two (2) cremation burials on one plot. Spreading of ashes is not allowed in any part of the cemetery.
9. Traditional Burials: A vault or grave liner are required for all casketed burials. Only one (1) traditional burial is allowed per plot.
10. Resale: Resale of lots must be back to the Village of Grantsburg at rates as set by the Village Board. Lot owners may not allow burials to be made in their lots for any remuneration or financial consideration.
